#### I. Bikeway & Pedestrian Items

- A. Bicycle & Pedestrian portion of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update: The consultant is still working on the final draft but plans to have that available later this month. The plan will then go to both City Councils for consideration and approval. The plan is a guide for staff and city policy makers for future planning. There is no funding to implement the entire plan, but a project cannot apply for funding if it is not in the plan.
- **B. 2023 Shared-use path plans for GF**: A shared-use path is part of the reconstruction project on South Washington from the southend drainway south to 62<sup>nd</sup> this season. In 2024, a shared-use path will be added along South 48<sup>th</sup> Street and will extend from 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue South to 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South. This will provide a connection for those traveling to the Industrial Park and will also connect the neighborhood in northwest GF to the 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue South retail corridor.
- **C. Sharing the Trail educational campaign discussion**: The group discussed potential topics for a public outreach campaign regarding sharing the trails and sharing the road.
  - i. Sharing the trail
    - 1. Ride or walk single file with encountering other trail users.
    - 2. Keep to the right.
    - 3. Signal your pass with a shout or other noise maker.
    - 4. Be aware of your surroundings.
    - 5. Keep pets on a short leash at all times.
    - 6. Slow down when encountering other trail users.
  - ii. Sharing the road
    - 1. Vehicles should "give 'em three" when passing cyclists.
    - 2. Cyclists should "take the lane" when necessary to been seen by drivers.
    - 3. Cyclists are required to ride single file on the streets.
  - iii. For everyone
    - 1. Be courteous.
- b. **Wayfinding signs:** Kim is working to put together a group of local agencies to work on a city-wide wayfinding sign plan.


