I. Bikeway items

- A. Wayfinding sign system: The group reviewed the data collection fields in the collector app. Items of discussion were:
 - i. Distance: A distance should be set for identifying destinations. Example: nothing past two miles should be indicated for direction. This might be impacted by the number of shared-use path intersections and other limitations.
 - ii. Destinations: The group agreed that most categories could be generalized (hospital, shopping, downtown GF & EGF, etc.) but unique destinations should be called out specifically (Alerus Center, etc.).
 - iii. Mileage: Include mileage on the directional signs.

II. Greenway Items

- A. EGF Deer Management Plan: The EGF City Council has approved a deer management plan that includes a bow hunt this fall. The hunt will not occur on state-owned land, including the campground, River Heights area, and the area around the boat landing on the Red Lake River. The City will use a lottery system to issue ten bow permits (nine antlerless and one buck). The hunters must pass a proficiency test and be assigned an area to hunt.
- B. Buoys: Fourteen river buoys have been ordered for placement in the Red River. These were purchased with Greenway funds, and the GF Sheriff's Department will manage the installation and removal. The buoys will designate downtown as a no-wake area and warn of the dam.
