Red River State Recreation Area: MNDOT Hwy 2 Easement 2016/17

MNDOT will be adding in a pedestrian lane on US Hwy 2. Construction will begin in Mid-May with a lease for a whole calendar year. The Greenway Trail will be closed under the bridge during construction with a dirt alternative away from the activities. MNDOT may connect the new walkway into the Greenway or stop it at River Road with a connection at a later date.
