I. Greenway Items

- i. **River Access Master Plan Update** – The draft is located online for the group to review (<http://www.greenwayggf.com/river-access-plan.html>). So far Kim Greendahl has only received three comments on the plan. Kim is looking at having a Public Meeting in January or February.
- ii. **Unpaved Trail System Update** – Kim Greendahl told the group that the trails have been groomed for skiing. The group was very pleased how great they are. Kim reminded the group that is being done by contract so they won't be groomed as frequently.
